



Game Day Operations

Game day can bring many surprises so the following article was put together to aid all team managers so that the players can play the game they love.

Going into a game day you would have already confirmed with the team manager of the other team the field location/number and time with them even if you are playing at home or away. If the game is at home you will have also confirmed on www.arbitersports.com the referee crew and field location of the game so that you know the referee contact details and that there are not going to be any conflicts at the field. Your arbiter login details will be sent to you before the season starts, please watch for your games especially games you have rescheduled.

At the game field, the referee will ask for the player passes of all team members together with either a lineup or game card. These should be brought completed by the team manager so that the coach can focus on getting the players ready for the game. These game or lineup cards should be obtained from the league website within your team account. It is also good to carry the emergency medical releases (EMR) of all players to gain good information on all players if an accident may occur or the tournament, league or site coordinator needs to check something on a particular player.

If you are playing a league game at home the assistant referees will need to be paid (the center referee is paid from the league office). CFJ pays the referees from the office so you will need to give them a signed A/R card, these are given out at the start of the season. For a MRL game, you will have to pay the referees before the game with the money the CFJ office will give you. Tournament and away game referees are paid for the team and you will not need to perform any task.

After the game the site coordinator or referee will send in the score of the game, the only thing you will need to do is make sure the player passes are given back. If a player is sent off the field, the referee will not give that particular player pass back to you.

NOTES:

- The correct players cards or EMR should be brought to the game (associated to the league) - there are multiple types.
- All login details are kept by the CFJ office, you can always call and ask for these.
